Did you know ? As a result of Brexit EU, EEA and EFTA citizens living in the UK will need to confirm their immigration status.

The EU Settled Status Scheme provides one option for people in this situation. But it is not necessarily the only option.

Brexit will put between 3-5 million Europeans into the UK Immigration rules for the first time.

Estimates for Greater Manchester suggest between 110,000 and 140,000 EU nationals are living in Greater Manchester

What is the EUSS?

When Britain leaves the EU European Treaty rights for the Free Movement of People will no longer apply in the UK.

European Citizens will come under normal immigration rules.

The EU Settled Status (EUSS) Scheme allows European Nationals living in the UK to obtain a permanent immigration status before this happens.

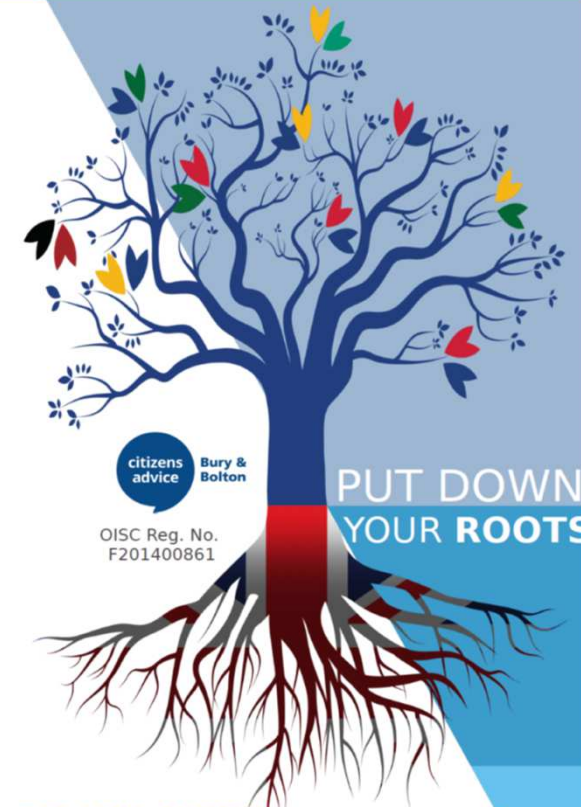

The current **deadline** for applying is **December 2020**.

Ratify your legal residence and rights in the UK.

Demonstrate that you are entitled to access the services that you need.

Make sure your children have a secure immigration status.

It's free to apply.

Rights & Entitlements

Right to work in the UK.

Right to use the NHS.

Right to enrol in education or continue studying.

Right to access public funds such as benefits and pensions, if you're eligible for them – if pre-settled you still need to prove you are 'habitually resident' in the UK.

Right to travel freely in and out of the UK.

Keep your right of entry to the UK and your residence status even if you live outside of the UK for up to 5 years. (Right to a five year absence).

Rights & Entitlements

You will have the right to be joined by eligible family members (at least up until March 2022)*

If you have **'settled status'** and then have children they will automatically be British citizens.*

If you have **'pre-settled status'**, children born in the UK will be automatically eligible for pre-settled status.**

How to apply

You are being asked to;

- Prove your identity
- Prove permanent residence in the UK (5 years continuous residence – no break of more than 2 years)
- Check if you are a 'fit an proper person' (criminal record check)

Start the process on your Phone;

- download App from app store: EU Exit ID document checker
- put in the relevant details
- scan your ID document
- take a photo of yourself when prompted

You will be asked to 'Retrieve your data'

click on this and then either;

- carry on your phone

or

- log in to a computer (using passport/id card number and d.o.b) to continue process on the computer <https://www.gov.uk/settled-status-eu-citizens-families/applying-for-settled-status>

If the application is for a child or a non EEA national

- you will be prompted to link the application to a sponsor (parent or partner) fill in your dob and reference number here if you want to do this.

Answer all the questions

Press the submit button

At the end the screen will say

- *“You are being considered for settled status”*
- **or**
- *“you need to provide more evidence”*

**If you need to provide more evidence upload this to the site.
*Best evidence - things that cover a whole year – council tax bills,
P60's tax credit or benefit award notices.***

At the end of the process you will receive 3 emails...

1) (straight away) Application number

2) (within a day or so) Confirmation email

3) (within a couple of weeks - normally) Your status outcome
